- Sound Editing: Participants learned how to edit and synchronize audio, add background music, and ensure clear narration.
- Final Project: The workshop concluded with participants working on their final projects, applying the skills they had acquired over the three days. Each participant presented their mobile documentary, receiving constructive feedback from the resource persons and peers.
