About Dum Dum Motijheel Rabindra Mahavidyalaya

Dum Dum Motijheel Rabindra Mahavidyalaya was established on 5th August, 1968 under the name of Dum Dum Motijheel Evening College of Commerce with affiliation from the Calcutta University. This institution saw its dawn through the untiring efforts of such respected educationists as Dr. B. B. Dutta, Sri B. K. Sen, Sri Sukumar Bhattacharya, Sri Santi Dasgupta and Sri Kumares Basu, the founder Principal. To start with, it was founded with the modest aim of providing facilities for studying Commerce Degree Course, General and Honours under Calcutta University and to cater to the needs of the working students through evening classes. Subsequently, under local demand and pressure, a full-fledged day Commerce College came into being, and the evening shift was done away with. Thus, the College was converted into a Day College in 1974 and accordingly it came to be known as Dum Dum Motijheel College of Commerce. Further, to face the challenges of globalization in the field of higher education and to suit the emerging need of the society at local, regional and national level, the Governing Body of the College resolved to convert the College of Commerce into a multi-faculty Degree College. The College accordingly was rechristened Dum Dum Motijheel Rabindra Mahavidyalaya in 2004 and the necessary approval from the University of Calcutta for introduction of Arts and Science streams was received. B.A./B.Sc. courses were introduced w.e.f. 2006-07. Now the college is affiliated to the West Bengal State University, Barasat, North 24 Parganas. At present the college offers B.Com (Hons.) in Accountancy & Finance and Marketing in commerce stream. In the B Sc. stream Geography (Hons.), Economics (Hons.) and Mathematics (General) are offered and in B.A stream the college offers Journalism & Mass Communication (Hons), History (Hons), Education (Hons), English (Hons), Bengali (Hons), Sociology (General), Philosophy (General), Political Science (General) and Sanskrit (General).

About Indian Council of Social Science Research (ICSSR)

The Indian Council of Social Science Research (ICSSR), was established as an autonomous organization in 1969, by the Ministry of Education (now known as the Ministry of Human Resource Development), Government of India. The primary objective of the ICSSR is to promote and fund research in the social sciences. Regional Centres were set up in the early days for the promotion of the objectives and activities of the ICSSR in the regions. The Eastern Regional Centre (ERC), established in Calcutta (at 10, Lake Terrace, Calcutta - 700 029) with the Centre for Studies in Social Sciences, Calcutta (CSSSC) as its host institution, started functioning from 1973. In May, 2012 the office of the ERC was shifted from 10, Lake Terrace, Kolkata - 700 029 to its new building at 1/R1, Baishnabghata Patuli Township, Kolkata - 700 094. The ERC covers the states of Bihar, Jharkhand, Odisha and West Bengal along with the Andaman and Nicobar Islands.

- To sanction Study Grants to scholars from the eastern region to visit libraries in India for short periods for their research.
- To maintain collections of books and periodicals in the social sciences.
- To undertake publication and assist publication of journals and books in social sciences.
- To support bibliographical work especially in regional languages.
- To organize and support conferences / seminars / workshops in the region.
- To grant partial financial support for research projects conducted in the region.
- To assist the visiting foreign scholars, invited by the ICSSR under Cultural Exchange Programme.
- To maintain a guest house for visiting scholars.
