

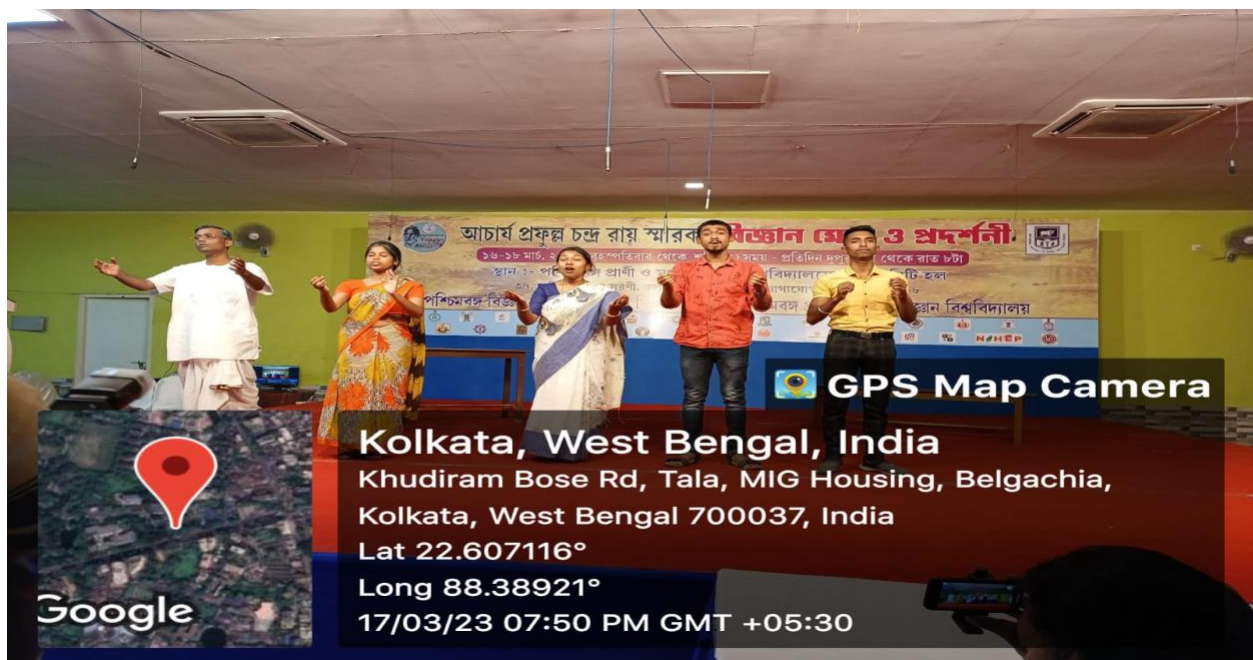

Team Dynamics:

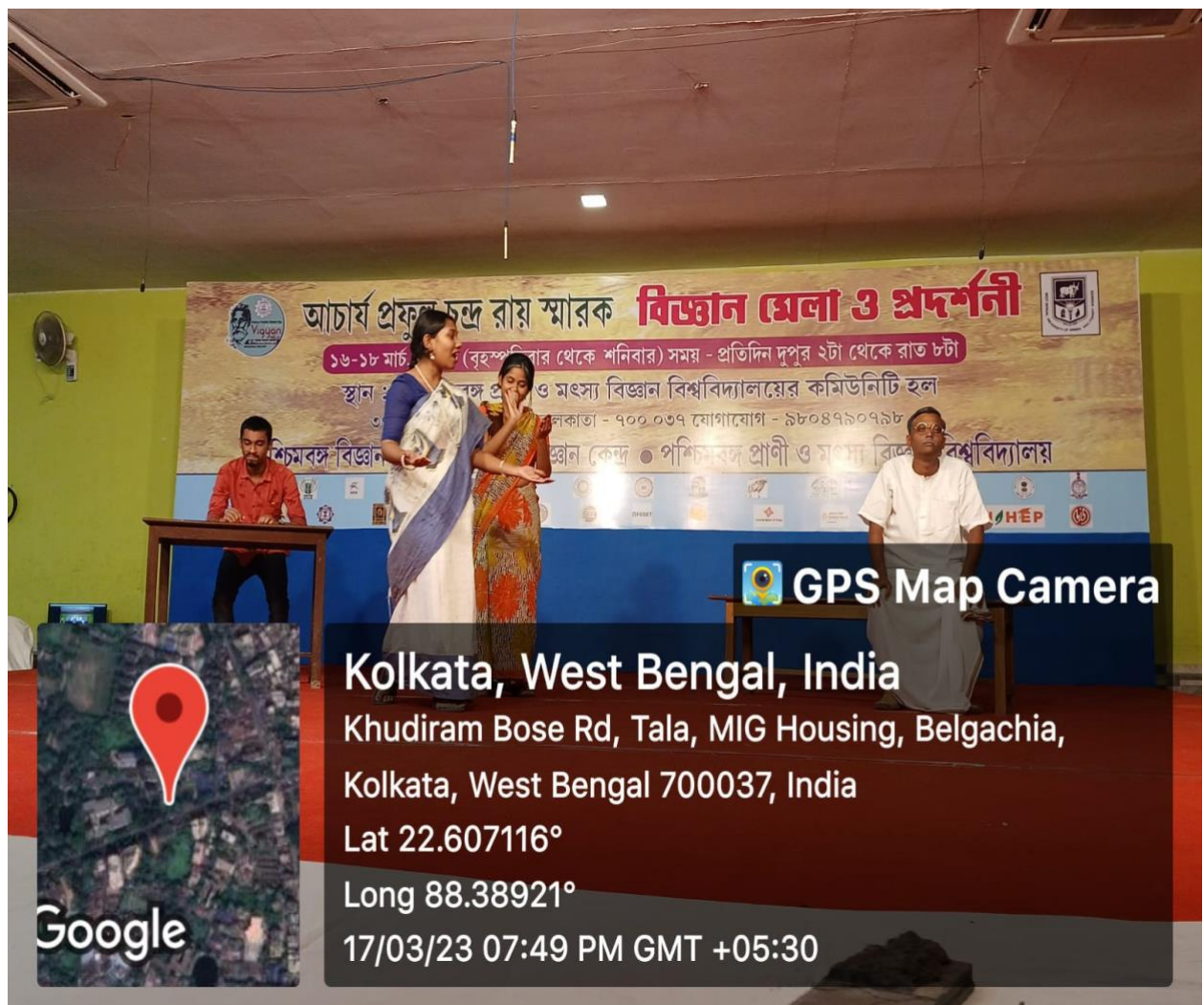
